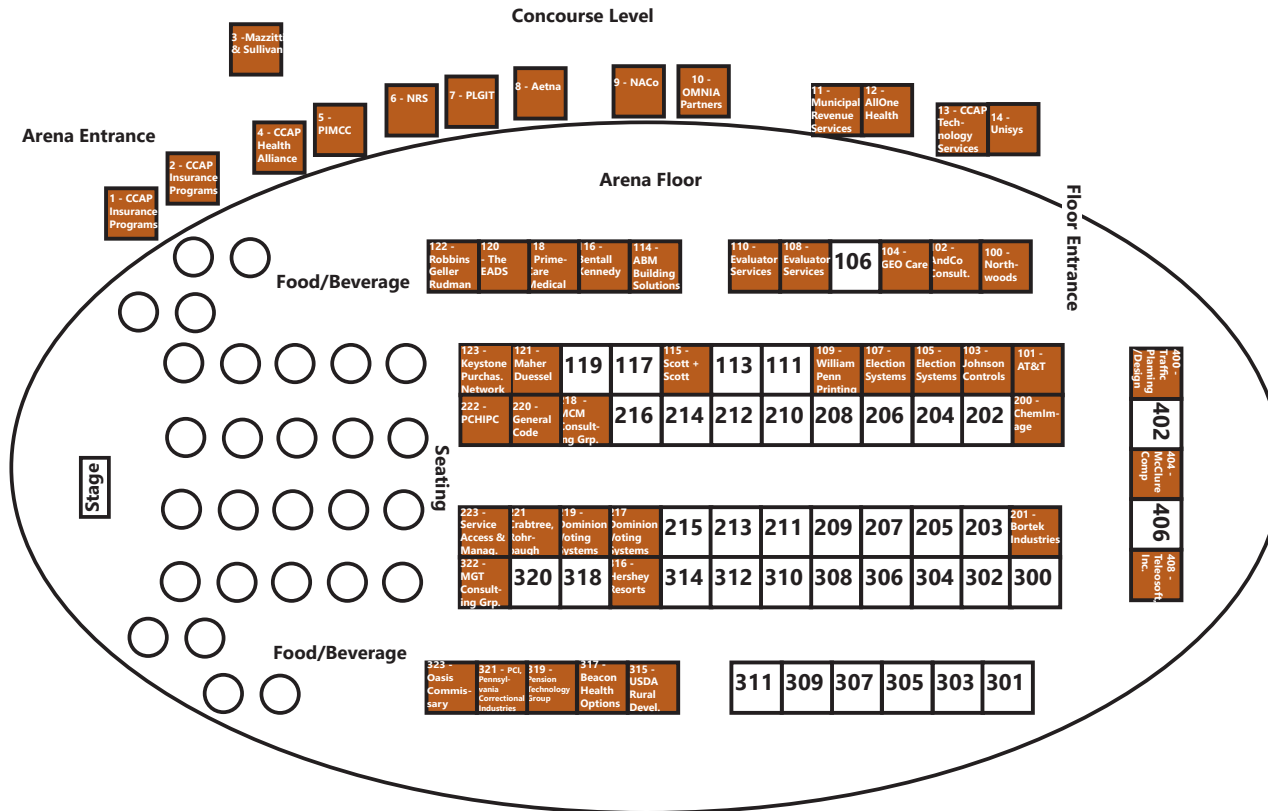


CCAP reserves the right to adjust the layout if deemed beneficial to exhibitors and attendees. Space is limited! There are 75 booths on the main exhibit floor that measure 10' deep by 10' wide and include one 8' skirted table, two chairs, a head sign and a wastebasket. There are also 14 booths on the concourse level with the same specifications. The exhibit area has only aisle carpeting; the flooring is concrete under the exhibits. Exhibitors may purchase carpeting and additional furniture for a fee using the electronic Exhibitor Service Request Form. Booth selection is on a first come, first paid basis.

There are 75 booths available on the main floor and 14 booths on the concourse level.

PAYMENT AND CONFERENCE CANCELLATION POLICIES

No booth assignments will be made and no badges or meal tickets will be issued until payment in full is received. Regardless of initial payment method, all refunds will be issued via check from CCAP.

Cancellation of Booth Personnel or Non-Exhibitor Individual Vendor Registration

Cancellations must be submitted via email to Jeannette Hunter at jhunter@pacounties.org and must be received by 4 p.m. on July 19, 2019 to qualify for a refund. No telephone cancellations will be accepted. A \$50 administrative fee will be deducted from each refund. Cancellations received after July 19 cannot be refunded. Registrations are transferable to another individual prior to the Conference start date; registered no-shows will be billed.

Cancellation of Booth Space

Cancellations must be submitted via email to Mandi Glantz at mglantz@pacounties.org and must be received by 4 p.m. on July 5, 2019 to qualify for a refund. No telephone cancellations will be accepted. A \$50 administrative fee will be deducted from each refund. Cancellations received between 4 p.m. on July 5 and 4 p.m. on July 19 will also be subject to an additional cancellation fee of 20 percent of the booth space purchase price. No refunds will be issued for cancellations received after 4 p.m. on July 19.
