PA Counties Risk Pool

All registered participants in the CCAP Academy for Excellence in County Government are eligible for the Academy Achievement Award. The Academy Achievement Award will be presented at the CCAP Academy graduation ceremonies and entitles the recipient to reimbursement of a portion of their initial Academy program registration fees (value \$400). To be eligible for the Academy Achievement Award, the participant must be actively enrolled in the CCAP Academy program, have fulfilled payment of Academy enrollment and registration fees and have completed all requirements for graduation from the program within an eight year period from time of initial enrollment. The recipient does not have to be from a county that is a participant in the PCoRP or PComp programs; the award is available to any eligible participant in the CCAP Academy for Excellence in County Government who has fulfilled the obligations previously noted. The financial reimbursement will be remitted via check to the party who issued the original registration fee for the CCAP Academy Program (county or individual). Effective March 2017.
