DESCRIPTION

Maintains county facilities, equipment and grounds; installs new equipment; rearranges and repairs existing equipment. Performs repairing of heating, ventilating, air conditioning, electrical and plumbing systems by completing carpentry, plumbing, electrical, masonry and painting functions. Duties also include any other tasks assigned by the Maintenance III worker and the Maintenance Supervisor.

SPECIFIC DUTIES

- Install, remove and move any electrical device in accordance with The National Electrical Code.
- Troubleshoot and repair electrical problems in 480, 277 and 120-volt systems.
- Designs and installs lighting systems.
- Installs, tags, and updates records of computer, phone and power cables.
- Prepares, completes, and files work orders.
- Establishes a preventative maintenance schedule on necessary electrical components and completes these tasks on schedule.
- Assists in maintaining heating ventilation air conditioning units by changing filters, adjusting and replacing belts and lube gears and motors.
- Rearranges office spaces by reading prints, measuring, moving portable walls, doors and ceiling, construction or demolition of walls and moving office furnishings.
- Updates drawings, charts, and any other records necessary with as built changes.
- Prepares, paints, stains and treats surfaces.
- Replaces faucet washers, sink traps, urinal and commode diaphragms and wax rings and toilet seats.
- Operates county truck to haul goods throughout the county.
- Sweeps, vacuums, mops, and any other custodial duties necessary to keep facilities appearance clean.
