


Average Weekly Wages in Pennsylvania Show Modest Increases

In second quarter of 2025, the average weekly wage in Pennsylvania was \$1,314, or \$93 below the U.S. average.

Summary


- In the second quarter of 2025, the average weekly wage in Pennsylvania was \$1,314, or \$93 lower than the national average.
- Between second quarter of 2024 to second quarter of 2025, the average weekly Pennsylvania wage increased 0.2 percent. The U.S. average increased 0.6 percent
- Within Pennsylvania, there were significant regional and rural / urban differences in the average weekly wage.

Average Weekly Wages in Pennsylvania and United States, 2nd Quarter 2024 to 2025 (Inflation Adjusted)



Within Pennsylvania, the second quarter 2025 average weekly wage in rural areas was \$1,080 or \$298 lower than the urban average of \$1,378. Wages in eastern Pennsylvania were higher (\$1,343) than those in western Pennsylvania (\$1,246).

Methodology
Data is from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages, U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Wage data was adjusted for inflation using the Consumer Price Index with June 2025 = 100. The analysis included only counties and their equivalent. Excluded are "unknowns" and undefined areas.
