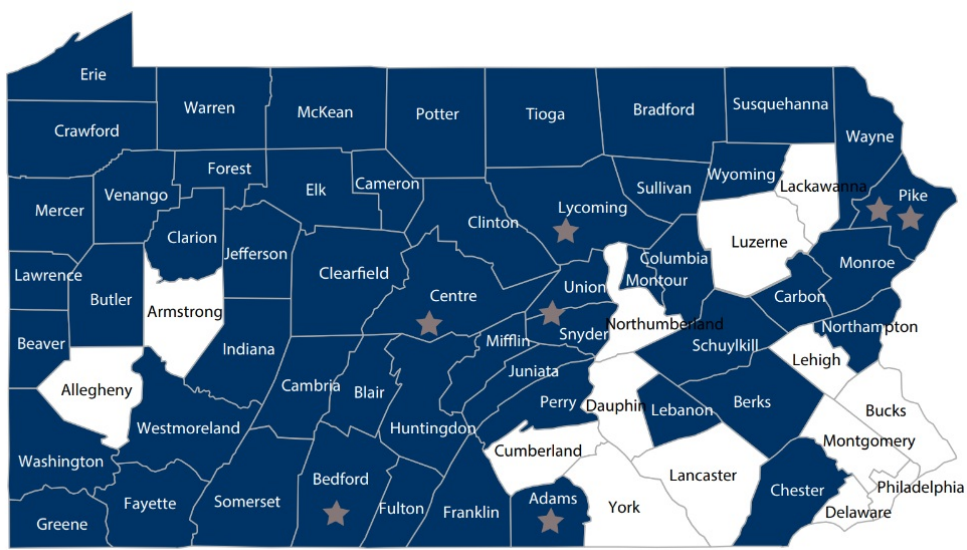


Crawford County Joins PIMCC

StopIt is the nation's leading Anonymous Reporting System and Safety Program that provides a safe and comfortable way for employees to share information anonymously with administrators in real-time. StopIt deters unwanted behavior in the workplace by allowing individuals to report behaviors such as harassment, sexual misconduct, threats, mental health issues and other safety concerns at any time - right from their phones.

As a member of PComp and PCoRP, your workplace can adopt the StopIt Anonymous Reporting System and Safety Program at **NO COST!**

How StopIt Works

The StopIt Mobile app, Web app, and Hotline provide a safe and comfortable way for employees to share information anonymously with administrators in real-time.



Step 1: Report an Incident

Tipster reports an incident using 1 of 4 methods (mobile app, website, telephone hotline, or walk-in)



Step 2: Monitor & Notify

Certified agents review, monitor, and escalate the tip (as needed)



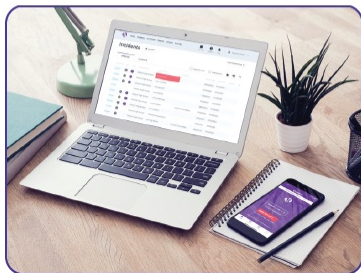
Step 3: Manage & Resolve

Admins are alerted via text, email and call (as needed) to review and act upon the incident



Address & Deter Issues Such As:

- Compliance Risk
- Sexual Misconduct
- Ethics Issues
- Mental Health Concerns
- Theft/Fraud
- Harassment
- Discrimination

Program Roll-Out, Launch and Sustainability

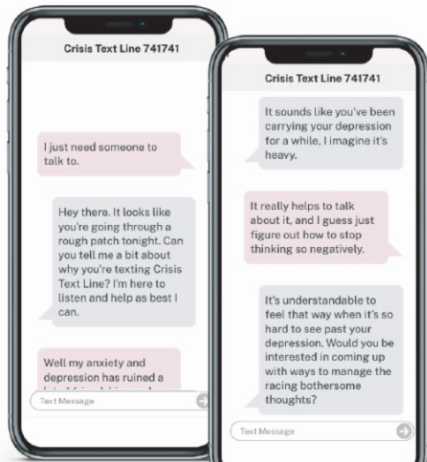

- ✓ **StopIt Admin** : Our comprehensive incident management system saves your administrators' time by helping them manage all incident reports in one system. Built-in analytics provide actionable data on trends and help identify areas for improvement.
- ✓ **Integration with Crisis Text Line**: Tipsters can connect with a Crisis Counselor from Crisis Text Line at any time via the StopIt Mobile or Web App.

StopIt also offers a Crisis Text Line that connects users with a crisis counselor 24/7. Integrated within the StopIt mobile app, Crisis Text Line™ provides immediate access to over 27,000 trained mental health counselors.

How it works?

CRISIS TEXT LINE

Crisis Text Line™ is available through the StopIt app from anywhere in the United States, anytime. A live, trained Crisis Counselor receives the text and responds, all from our secure online platform. The Crisis Counselor is trained to help you move from a hot to a cool place.



A Typical Intervention

1. You initiate a conversation with Crisis Text Line Counselors via StopIt App
2. We encourage you to share
3. We work with you to help you understand your feelings
4. Conversations usually end with you in a better place
5. Other times we may just keep listening OR refer you to others who can provide immediate help
