York County's Water Quality Innovation Spotlighted at State Hearing



On October 9, the House Republican Policy Committee held a public hearing highlighting York County's cutting-edge water quality monitoring initiative. Wade Gobrecht, Director of the York County Planning Commission, outlined the county's partnership with the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) to launch a real-time water quality monitoring system in 2025. The 10-year project will provide watershed-level data to guide targeted mitigation strategies and long-term water quality improvements.

York County President Commissioner Julie Wheeler noted that the initiative could serve as a model for other counties across the Commonwealth. Featured in both CCAP and NACo publications, the project demonstrates how data-driven collaboration can strengthen water management efforts statewide.

The hearing underscored York County's leadership in environmental innovation and its partnership with USGS to advance data-informed solutions.
