

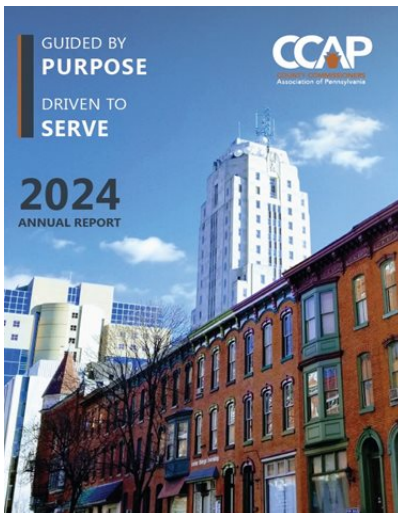

PBDA Opens Second Round of Digital Connectivity Technology Program

The CPF-Digital Connectivity Technology Program, led by the Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority (PBDA), helps expand digital access across Pennsylvania by providing laptops for broadband connectivity, digital literacy, and skills training.

Applications can request between 20 and 200 laptops. The second round of funding is expected to open in March or April 2025, with a 60-day application window.

Who can apply?

- Community Anchor Institutions (CIAs)
- Municipalities and local governments
- Nonprofits
- Previous applications who were unsuccessful
- Previous successful applications who received fewer than 200 laptops

Applications must be submitted through the Electronic Single Application portal. Program guidelines, FAQs, and more details are available on the CPF-Digital Connectivity Technology Program webpage.

A250PA PA Day Mini Grants Now Open for Applications

America250PA has announced that the application process for the 2025 A250PA Pennsylvania Day Mini Grants is now open.

The Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial (America250PA) was established in 2018 by the legislature and Governor to plan and coordinate the 250th anniversary of the U.S., highlighting Pennsylvania's role and its people's impact on the nation's history and future.

National Pennsylvania Day, celebrated on July 20th, is a key part of the A250PA initiative. In collaboration with supporters across the Commonwealth, America250PA designates this day for volunteerism, encouraging individuals to positively impact their communities. The goal is to expand this effort each year through 2026, highlighting the importance of volunteerism in strengthening communities.

Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful Mini grants are available to existing America250PA partners (must have been a partner as of December 31, 2024) conducting projects that improve the community and engages volunteers. Projects could include community cleanups, park improvements, revitalization efforts, river sweeps, graffiti abatement, murals, etc.* **Projects must engage community volunteers and be held July 19 on National Pennsylvania Day. The project location must be located in PA.**

Interested groups can apply for \$250 up to \$4,000 in funding for a local activation in support of National Pennsylvania Day, July 19.

Applications will close on March 24th, 2025 at 5:00 pm. Selected applicants will be notified in April. Click the below link to apply.

New Funding Opportunity from YFTI

The University of Pittsburgh's Youth and Family Training Institute (YFTI) is partnering with the Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS) Bureau of Children's Behavioral Health Services and Bureau of Policy, Planning & Program Development to develop and launch a two-year pilot program.

This initiative will define, develop, and evaluate the role of the Family Navigator at up to six sites across Pennsylvania. The pilot aims to test the effectiveness of family navigator models for children, youth, and young adults (CYA) with serious emotional disturbances (SED), promoting early access, engagement, and coordination of mental health services for CYA aged 5-21 and their family caregivers.

- Up to six sites across the Commonwealth will receive up to \$250,000 each year for the 2-year pilot.
- Counties, provider organizations, health facilities, or other public, private or non-profit entities within Pennsylvania that serve children, youth and young adults aged 5-21 are eligible to apply.
- A diversity of sites is being sought in various contexts such as setting (urban, suburban, rural) and target population.
