### PFAS Cost Recovery Opportunity

An important legal opportunity to recover costs associated with [PFAS](#) (polyfluoroalkyl substances) contamination in drinking water systems is available.

All public entities—including counties, towns, cities, villages, authorities, airports, and wastewater systems—are eligible to participate.

Any public water system with a potential PFAS detection from September 2024 onward should take immediate steps to preserve eligibility. Airports and wastewater systems that have spent any funds on PFAS-related mitigation or remediation are also strongly encouraged to file.

### Road and Bridge Safety Improvement Award

Each year, CCAP, the Pennsylvania Highway Information Association (PHIA), and the PA Department of Transportation (PennDOT) work together to recognize the best road and bridge safety improvement projects undertaken by local governments across the commonwealth.

This year's award recipient was the Allegheny County Department of Public Works for the Armstrong Tunnel Rehabilitation Project.

One of many key improvements was to expand the protected sidewalk for pedestrians to 75" to accommodate wheelchair access by repurposing the existing roadway width and establishing a single travel lane in each direction that expands to two lanes at the traffic signals at each exit.



The award was presented to Jason Molinero of Allegheny County by Chris Metka from the PA Department of Transportation and Jason Wagner from the PA Highway Information Association.
