



## **Guidelines for Sponsoring a Hospitality Suite or Reception during the 2026 Annual Conference and Trade Show, August 2- 5 at Kalahari Resorts & Conventions.**

The County Commissioners' Association of Pennsylvania offers the following guidelines for those coordinating public or private functions scheduled during the Annual Conference:

- CCAP does not allot hospitality suites or function space. This must be done directly with Kalahari Resorts & Conventions. **Please contact Betty Veliz at [bveliz@kalahariresorts.com](mailto:bveliz@kalahariresorts.com).** The hotel will assign the function space on a first-come, first-served basis. Please make arrangements early since space is limited.
- CCAP requests that at least one representative from each company or organization hosting a Hospitality Suite, reception or dinner be registered for the full Conference.
- Please be considerate of scheduled Conference-wide activities. You may schedule your Hospitality Suites Sunday evening at 6:30 p.m. or after, Monday or Tuesday evening at 8:30 p.m. or after. CCAP thanks you for acknowledging the importance of county member attendance at our scheduled Conference events. We invite all registered attendees to participate in Conference activities as registration allows. If space limitations apply, preference will be granted to county member attendees first.
- A complete schedule of Conference events and activities, including a listing of hospitality functions, will be included in the Conference mobile app. Please confirm the details of your event with Patty Stroble at [ppstroble@pacounties.org](mailto:ppstroble@pacounties.org) prior to the Conference.
- CCAP is unable to distribute emails or fliers promoting your hospitality suite or function. You may wish to send emails or post fliers at the hosting facility with the permission of the hotel representative.
- If you have drawings or giveaways, you are responsible for getting prizes to the winners. The CCAP registration desk is unable to hold prizes. Companies are cautioned to use good judgment in offering gifts and/or holding gift raffles for public officials and public employees who must adhere to the Pennsylvania Ethics Act and their own county's policy regarding acceptance of gifts and hospitality.
