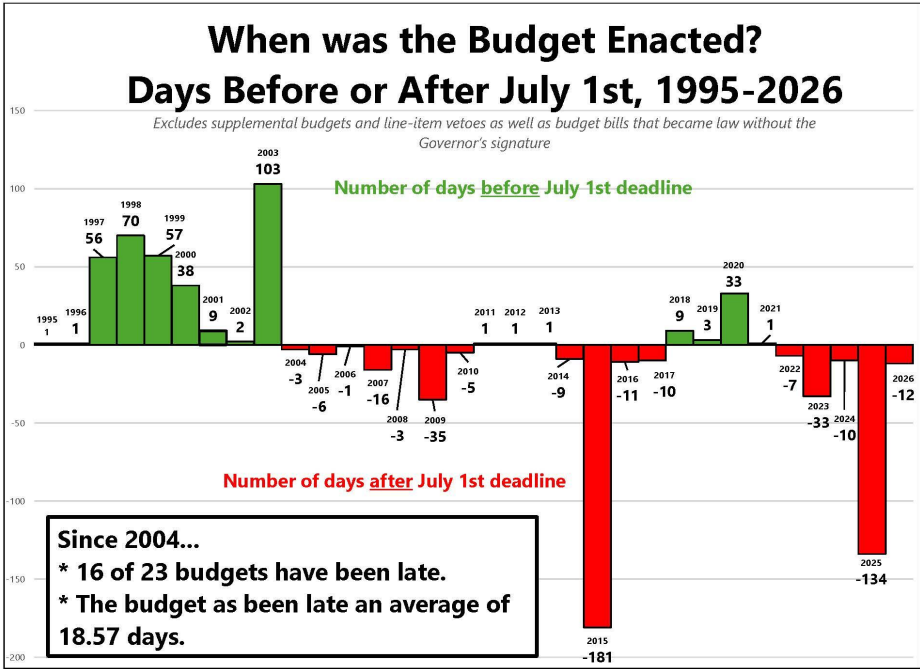

On Sunday, July 12, the General Assembly and the Governor finalized the Fiscal Year 2026–2027 state budget.

As part of the agreement, both the General Appropriations Act ([Act 1A of 2026](#)) and the Fiscal Code ([Act 21 of 2026](#)) were enacted. The Fiscal Code provides the statutory framework governing how appropriated funds are distributed and administered across state programs.

The FY 2026–2027 budget includes approximately \$50.8 billion in General Fund spending, representing a 3.7% increase over the previous fiscal year.

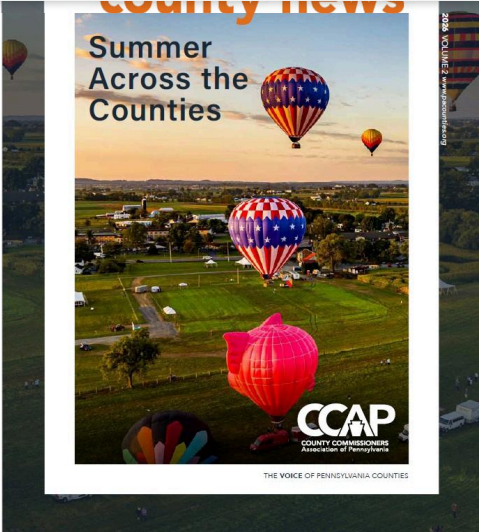
