








Pennsylvania Continues to Gain More New Residents Through In-Migration

Summary

- In 2024, 249,909 people moved into Pennsylvania, and 213,825 moved out of the state. The net-migration was 36,084
- 20 percent of those who moved into Pennsylvania in 2024 were from another country or U.S. Territory.
- 35 percent of those who moved out of Pennsylvania went to an adjoining state.
- Adults moving into and out of Pennsylvania are demographically similar.



Characteristics of Adults Who Moved Into and Out of Pennsylvania , 2024




Methodology

Data source: 2024, 1-year Average American Community Survey Public Use Microdata Sample (PUMS), U.S. Census Bureau. Included in this analysis were people 18 years old and older and people who did not live in an institutional group quarter.
