On behalf of [YOUR COUNTY], we write today to urge you to support reauthorization of the 911 surcharge ahead of the January 2026 sunset date. **Furthermore, we are requesting an increase of the 911 surcharge rate from \$1.95 to \$2.20 to ensure there is sufficient funding for this essential service provided by counties.**

[YOUR COUNTY] is proud to provide one of the key functions in public safety—the operation of the 911 call-taking and dispatch system. Under counties’ administration, Pennsylvania’s system is by all measures one of the most effective, efficient and technologically compliant systems in the nation. The 911 fee, reauthorized and set at \$1.95 by Act 34 of 2023, is the primary funding source for the critical 911 system and pays for personnel, equipment, and future technologies to enhance the emergency services process.

However, the surcharge provisions of Act 34 are set to expire on January 31, 2026 – just nine months away. Without prompt action from Governor Shapiro and the General Assembly to reauthorize and increase the surcharge to meet current need, counties like ours will effectively be forced to prepare for funding cuts to the 911 system as we prepare our budget for 2026 and have to pass on the burden of that cost to property tax payers across the board as county general funds are the other source of funding for the 911 system.
