

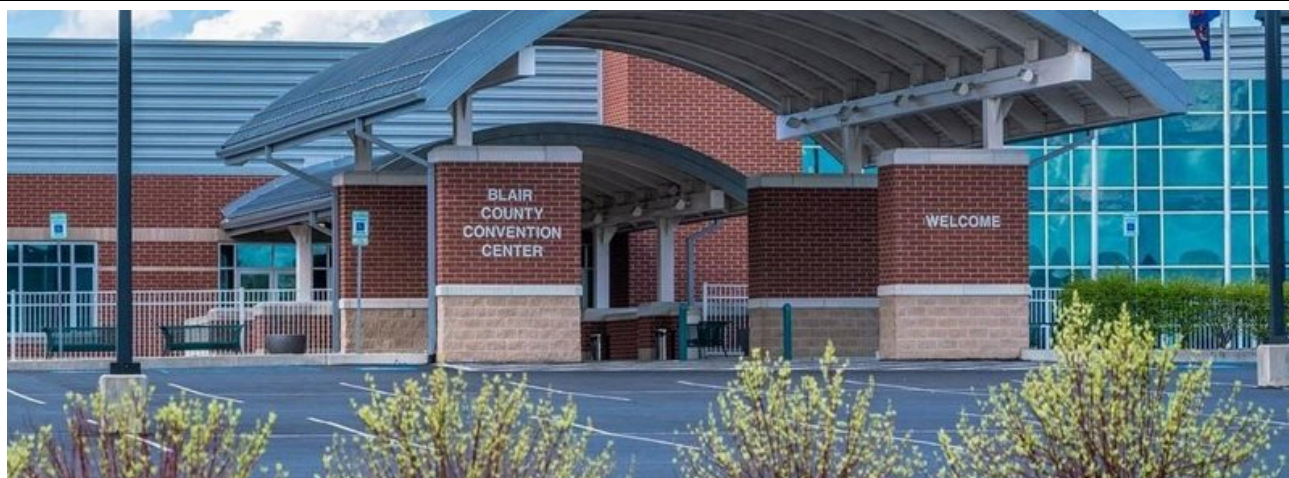

Growing Greener Plus Grants Program

Applications for the [Growing Greener Plus](#) grants program to improve or protect Commonwealth waters are now open until June 20, 2025.

Eligible applicants for Growing Greener grants include counties, municipalities, municipal authorities, county conservation districts, watershed organizations, councils of governments, educational institutions and other authorized organizations involved in water resource restoration

Grant applications and all attachments must be submitted through the [Commonwealth's eGrant system](#).

Watershed Planning and Restoration Grants

The DEP administers a grant program to fund watershed projects that are part of the approved watershed implementation plan (WIP).

The [Watershed Planning and Restoration Grants](#) aim to protect and improve Pennsylvania's waters by addressing nonpoint source pollution from agriculture, abandoned mine drainage (AMD), stormwater runoff, energy extraction, and streambank or shoreline degradation.

Eligible applicants include watershed associations, municipalities, counties, county conservation districts, councils of governments, nonprofit organizations, educational institutions, and municipal authorities.

Applications and all supporting documents will be accepted now until June 20, 2025, through the [Commonwealth's eGrant system](#).
